Comprehensive Community Health Centers (CCHC) receives new funding to help increase enrollment in Medi-Cal and other programs

HEALTH Net announced it is awarding \$1.965 million in grants to help enroll, educate and retain eligible members in Medi-Cal, the state's health care safety net program.

The grant is part of a total of \$1.9 million in grants Health Net is awarding to Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC), Community Based Organizations (CBO) and clinic consortia in California. "To date, CCHC patients and those underserved and un-

derinsured individuals in our service area have encountered multiple barriers to accessing healthcare, lack of awareness of available resources and difficulty navigating government-sponsored insurance program during the current pandemic conditions," said Pedro Ramirez, Director of Outreach and Community Engagement. "With this grant from Healthnet, CCHC will ensure that low-income families and individuals in our service

area will have access to community-driven, patient-centered, affordable, and comprehensive health services as well as other needed resources."

CCHC will use the grants to increase enrollment, retention and navigation within the health care system by providing low-income individuals with health coverage educations and patient navigation services, and enroll them in appropriate health coverage. ■
