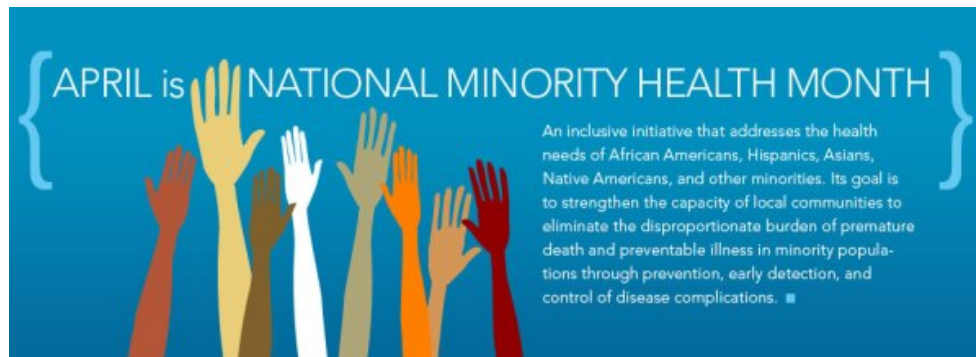

# Public Charge Update



## Public Charge Update: Biden Administration Ends Trump-Era Public Charge Rule

March 24, 2021

### Overview of Update:

On March 9, 2021, the Biden administration dropped its defense of the Trump public charge rule. As a result, the U.S. Supreme Court and the Seventh Circuit dismissed the pending cases, bringing an end to the Trump's Administration public charge rule. A district court order vacating the rule is now final. The long-standing 1999 "field guidance" (the policy that was in place before the 2019 Rule) will apply effective immediately, making it safe for immigrants and their families to use health, nutrition, and housing programs for which they qualify.

*This means that health care programs, including Medicaid and COVID care, housing assistance, food programs, and many other vital services are once again safe to use.*

### Key Items to Remember / Share w Patients:

- Individuals who have their green card, will not be assessed for public charge when they apply to become a citizen.
- It is important to note that if somebody with a green card leaves the country for more than 180 consecutive days (6 months), they can be treated as a new entrant and assessed for public charge and other grounds of inadmissibility when they seek to re-enter the country.
- Public charge does not apply to: Refugees, asylees, survivors of domestic violence, and victims of trafficking or other serious crimes, special immigrant juveniles, temporary protected status (TPS), and certain other groups.
- A family member's or dependents use of public programs cannot affect your future immigration applications.
- Testing, treatment, and preventative services for COVID-19 — including vaccines — are not part of public charge. Pandemic relief payments (stimulus checks) are also not part of public charge.
